Saturday 13th July - The BIG DAY

- **Exhibition** 11am to 4pm at the Maltings, Staithe Street, (free)
- **Historic Lifeboats on display** 11am to 3.30pm at the outer harbour pontoons at the beach end of Beach Road (open to the public and free)
- **Presentation Ceremony** 12 noon to 1.30pm at the Boathouse
Lifeboat volunteers and invited guests only
- **Boathouse Open** 2pm to 4.15pm (open to the public and free)
See the boats, meet the crew, refreshments on sale
- **Lifeboat Flotilla** 4.30pm to 5.15pm Wells all-weather lifeboat, “The Doris M Mann”, and inshore lifeboat, “Peter Wilcox”, lead the lifeboat flotilla from the outer harbour to the main quay and sail past the harbour office before returning to the boathouse. View from the beach bank and the main quay (free)
- **Lifeboats re-housed** 5.30pm to 6pm Wells lifeboats recovered onto their carriages and re-housed. View from the beach end of the beach bank (free)
- **Lifeboat Volunteers’ Supper** (invite only) 7pm

All times approximate. Lifeboats may be called away for operational duties.
