
<u>Swimmers:</u> <u>Staying safe around Burnham Overy Staithe and Scolt Head Island</u>









- 1. Wells Bar high tide time: **one** hour either side is safest
- 2. Make sure you can be seen: wear a brightly coloured swimming hat/tow float
- 3. Stay near the land: in particular **avoid** the area near the Harbour Mouth (red circle)
- 4. Calling for help: keep fully charged mobile phone in a waterproof pouch around your neck
- 5. Take care when entering the water: you will need time to acclimatise to the cold water
